Airport transfer both ways

Arrival

Upon arrival at Sydney airport, our driver will pick you up and take you to your homestay, making sure you meet your host.

Departure

On return, our driver will pick you up from your homestay, drive you to the airport and drop you off at the departure terminal express drop off bay, just outside your airline counters.



Homestay

Experience the joy of cultural exchange and genuine hospitality, and improve your English by speaking with your host family every day.



Fantastic families

Families are carefully selected for their warmth and genuine interest in the student's wellbeing.

Quality standards

We have a dedicated Homestay Coordinator who ensures that our students are always well looked after. We regularly inspect homes to ensure that the high standards are maintained. We actively collect feedback from all students about their stay with their host family to ensure that they feel comfortable and welcome.

Location

All homes are located close to public transport and usually 35 to 60 minutes' travel time to the college.

Facilities

The student's bedroom will be furnished with a single or double bed, a wardrobe, a dressing table or chest of drawers, adequate lighting and a desk. If there is no desk in the bedroom students will have a space elsewhere in the house where they can study comfortably.

Internet

Internet access will be made available to students at the homestay but usually at extra cost. All students will have free unlimited internet access from our computer lab and WiFi service at school.

Other students

Most host families only accommodate one student but some families welcome 2 or more international students. When that's the case, we will make sure that there are no other students of the same nationality / mother tongue in the household.

Laundry

Bed linen and towels are provided and washed by the host family. The student's clothes will be washed together with the family wash.

GuardianshipSERVICE

Local caregiver, all-round care

Students on our Globetrotter program will be well-looked after all along their stay:

In addition to the care and support from the ELC team of teachers and from Student Services staff at school, as well as the care and guidance from their homestay family, each student on the Globetrotter program will be assigned a dedicated guardian for the duration of their enrolment

In case of illness, personal issues or emergency, this appointed caregiver will be able to step in and assist 24/7.

This service offers an extra layer of reassurance and comfort for both parents and students and is included for all students taking part in our Globetrotter program, covering them from the moment they arrive to the moment they depart.





Getting to school Every day transport

- > Sydney's transport system is easy, safe and reliable.
- > Total travel time from homestay is 35-60min door-to-door
- > Transportation may be train or bus
- > Host families will help with:
 - How to purchase and use a transport card (at own cost)
 - Practising the walk to the local bus stop or train station
 - Planning the trip to school

Most families practice the full trip from their house to school with you on the weekend or take you to school on your first morning.

Meals

The Globetrotter package price includes:

- > Breakfast every day
- > Lunch on the weekend
- > Dinner every day

Lunch on weekdays:

Students generally purchase their lunch from a local food court opposite the school on weekdays. This allows them to choose their meal according to their own preference, to practise their English and to develop their independence. The school features a kitchen area students can sit in to enjoy their lunch together.

Packed lunches on weekdays:

Alternatively, we also offer the option of daily packed lunches prepared by the host family (usually a sandwich and piece of fruit). This needs to be booked as an optional extra service.

As part of our package D - Globetrotter services, our drivers will:

- > Pick the student up from their homestay
- > Drive them to the airport
- > Drop them off at the departure terminal express drop off bay 3hrs prior to their flight departure time.

The Sydney Airport departure terminal is very easy to navigate and our driver will make sure to drop students off just outside of their airline counters. It is typically only a 20-metre walk from where our driver will drop them off to their airline's check-in counters.

This service is included in the Package D - Globetrotter price and is the preferred option for most families.

However, 3 upgrade options are available if required, as presented on the next pages.

- > Park at one of the airport car parks and walk with them to their check-in counter, ensuring they are in the correct check-in lane.

After this, our driver will leave the airport.

Excellent upgrade for peace of mind! For an extra level of reassurance, families may choose to upgrade to this service.

When this extra service is requested, our driver will:

- > Pick the student up from their homestay
- > Drive them to the airport
- > Park at one of the airport car parks and walk with them to their check-in counter, ensuring they are in the correct check-in lane.
- > Wait in the check-in queue with them
- > Assist them with their check-in, liaising with the airline staff on their behalf
- > Make sure they receive their boarding pass
- > Walk with them to the entrance of the security check section of the airport.

At this stage, members of the public are no longer allowed to accompany travellers. Our driver will say goodbye and leave the airport.

NB: in case students are flying using their airline's UMS (Unaccompanied Minor Service) and this upgrade option meets the airline's requirements, our driver will be able to complete the required UMS paperwork as part of this service and will make sure to hand the student over to their dedicated airline staff, who will look after them from that point on. However note that in order to meet some airlines requirements, upgrade option 3 may be required.

The ultimate upgrade option for UMS (Unaccompanied Minor Service) travellers whose airline requires the drop off person to stay at the airport until the flight has taken off.

If the student is travelling using their airline's UMS, this upgrade option may be required to comply with the airline's procedures and conditions. When this extra service is requested, our driver will:

- > Pick the student up from their homestay
- > Drive them to the airport
- > Park at one of the airport car parks and walk with them to their check-in counter, ensuring they are in the correct check-in lane
- > Wait in the check-in queue with them
- > Assist them with their check-in, liaising with the airline staff on their behalf
- > Make sure they receive their boarding pass
- > Handle all required UMS paperwork
- > Hand the student over to their dedicated airline staff.

As part of the UMS service, the dedicated airline staff will go through immigration, security and take the child all the way to their boarding gate, as per airline service description.

To comply with airline requirements, our driver will stay at the airport until the flight has taken off.

Safety

FOR ALL PARTICIPANTS

Safe city

According to the Economist Intelligence Unit (EIU)'s latest safe cities index (issued in 2021), Sydney ranked 4th safest major city worldwide. According to their more recent most liveable cities index (issued in 2025), Sydney ranks 6th most liveable city worldwide.

Excellent ELC location

ELC is located right in the city centre, in a well renowned area, very close to public transport.

Working with Children clearance

All ELC staff, teachers and leaders that juniors will deal with hold a Working With Children Clearance.

Group leaders on all activities

An ELC group leader will accompany all students on their afternoon activities, with a maximum ratio of 1 leader per 15 students.

FOR PARTICIPANTS ENROLLED IN PACKAGE D - GLOBETROTTER

Airport transfer both ways

Our full package includes return airport transfer.

For students who require extra support or who are travelling as "Unaccompanied Minor" our driver can handle the documentation required at the airport upon pick up and return as part of our optional airport drop off upgrade services.

Guardianship service

In addition to the services that the ELC team provides to all students throughout the program, students enrolled in our Globetrotter package also benefit from the services of an appointed local guardian. This service means that each student will have a dedicated support person. Their guardian may act as a mediator in case any issues arises and in case of medical emergency.

24/7 emergency contact

In case of emergency, an experienced ELC staff or their appointed local guardian will assist students, 24/7, from the moment they land to the moment they depart Sydney.

Range

This program caters for teenagers aged 12-17.

- > Students aged 14-17 may enrol into any package (Learner, Explorer, Explorer+ or Globetrotter)
- > Students aged 12-13 may only join the program if they are coming as part of a group or staying with relatives in Sydney and enrolling into our Learner or Explorer package. They are not eligible for our Explorer+ or Globetrotter Package.
