

House rules

These guidelines are intended to enhance your safety, comfort, and enjoyment at Scape, as well as that of all the other residents.

Common Areas: Keep shared areas clean and tidy. Clean up after yourself in the kitchen and common spaces.

- If any kitchen utensils/item is missing or broken, please advise ELC Accommodation team by email: accommodation@elc.edu.au
- Maintain open and respectful communication with roommates and staff to address any concerns or issues promptly.

Cooking is only permitted in designated kitchen spaces. Cooking appliances should not be used in living areas or bedrooms to prevent fire hazards.

Quiet hours: 10pm to 7am.

- **Guest Policy:** Please inform roommates in advance if you plan to have guests and ensure they abide by house rules.
- **Permitted Hours:** Weekdays until 9pm and Weekends until 10pm. No overnight stays allowed.

Security: Keep doors locked and do not let strangers into the residence. Report any security concerns to the management immediately.

No smoking or drugs. This is strictly prohibited on the premises. Illegal drugs or activities, including possession, use, or sale, are strictly prohibited. Violation will result in disciplinary action, potentially involving law enforcement.

For safety reasons, certain appliances such as heaters with exposed elements, small fan heaters, bar heaters, and refrigerators are not allowed. Only heaters or fans provided by SCAPE are permitted.

Dispose of waste properly: Avoid leaving waste in common areas or near garbage bins. Keep access to facilities clear. SCAPE Management reserves the right to remove obstructions and levy charges for damages.

Compliance with rules: Failure to comply with house rules may result in disciplinary action, including eviction from the residence with no refund.
